Indeed 2020 has been a terrible year for all of us, but for an RNA Molecular Biologist as myself it has also been the impressive year in which two unprecedented RNA-based vaccines are being developed and used against an RNA virus! Never as today, I felt the duty, as a citizen who also is a scientist and a scientist who is also a citizen, of being a skilled Science Communicator, to help people navigate through these difficult times with rationality and insight: "Is the virus mutating?"; "Is the vaccine safe?"; "Where does the virus come from?". I am determined to contribute to the dissemination and communication tasks of SIBBM, and to support its role in forming and informing policy makers.

- Finally, I highly value the **multidisciplinarity** that characterises our Scientific Society, whose members daily integrate Molecular Biology with neighbouring disciplines such as Bioinformatics, Computational Biology, Structural Biology, Biophysics etc., in a vibrating environment which produces outstanding Science. Multidisciplinarity is not easy, however, as people from different backgrounds need to "learn to speak a common language". To that end, I believe that SIBBM will have an instrumental role in the education of new generations of multidisciplinary scientists, also through the organization of Courses and Workshops.
- In conclusion, I express my availability to serve as Counsellor for the SIBBM for the next three years and I look forward to the coming challenges and opportunities.
