A **Postdoctoral fellow position** is open to join the team of Dr. Valentina Cianfanelli, at the Department of "Women, children and public health sciences" of Fondazione Policlinico Universitario A. Gemelli, in the Unit of "Cancer Gynaecology", led by Prof. Giovanni Scambia.

Where: The workplace is the Fondazione Policlinico Universitario A. Gemelli IRCCS, Rome, Italy.

When: The position is available as early as June 2023, and is funded through a 3-year grant: the Ricerca Finalizzata Giovani Ricercatori (Ministry of Health) to Dr. Valentina Cianfanelli.

What: The postdoctoral fellow will be involved in a very exciting project about the role of protein phosphatases and autophagy in gynaecological cancer development, progression and resistance to chemotherapy. We will exploit state of the art imaging techniques, and gene editing and "-omics" approaches (transcriptomics and proteomics) in relevant cellular and mouse models.
