POST-DOCTORAL POSITION

One fellowship is available in the laboratory of Immunology and Immunopathology at the Department of Molecular Medicine, Sapienza University of Rome to work on a project aim to dissect the role of mast cells in the progression of colon cancer, under the supervision of Prof. Rossella Paolini. The project is part of a funded AIRC research project entitled "Unraveling the role of mast cells in colorectal cancer" and a funded project from Istituto Pasteur Italia-Fondazione Cenci Bolognetti (Call 2020) entitled "Dissecting the role of mast cell during the transition from intestinal inflammation to colon cancer".

The position is ideally offered for two years, and can be renewed for up to four years.

The candidate must be highly motivated and have a PhD in Immunology or related sciences since he/she is expected to closely interact with a team of immunologists.

The successful candidate must have a proven previous experience in animal handling and isolation/culture of primary cells as well as good communication and interpersonal skills to conduct independent research.
