Overall research efforts, at the interface between basic and clinical sciences, are on sex differences in cancer susceptibility, with a specific focus on androgen signalling in skin aging and cancer (melanoma). Requirements :

- PhD in Cell Biology or Genetics, or MD with > 2 years basic research experience
- At least two first author papers in high-ranking journals (impact factor >8)
- Skills in bioinformatic analysis of large data sets
- Writing and organizational skills
- Demonstrated capability to work independently and collaborate/supervise work of others
